The best poster award will be granted at the end of the conference.

- Visual interaction through multi-modality
- Visual modeling languages and UML
- Visual programming languages
- Visualization on mobile devices

Submission Instructions

Authors must submit a two-page summary in the same PDF format as is required for the VINCI 2011 papers. Submissions should be sent via email to the Poster Chair (Yingcai Wu) at vinciposter2011@gmail.com

Authors will be notified of poster acceptance/rejection by email in several days.

Information for Authors

Authors of accepted posters are required to bring a large hardcopy poster for display. Posters have no predefined formatting, but the dimensions may not exceed A0 paper size (841mm X 1189mm). Posters are not considered archival publications and thus can have subsequent full papers submitted to other conferences or journals.
